The U.S. Department of Education and/or Vermont State University selected your file for "Verification". The Financial Aid office is required to compare the information from your FAFSA application with the information on this Household Size form and sometimes other financial documents. The law says we have the right to ask for this information as this is a legal requirement in order to receive federal aid. If there are differences between your application and your financial documents, we will send corrections electronically to the U.S. Department of Education. If corrections are made, you will then receive an updated Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Central Processor (CPS). This may result in an adjustment to your estimated financial aid. **Financial Aid payments will not be posted to your Student Account until all verification requirements have been met and the necessary corrections have been made.**

What you should do:

1. Complete and sign this form. **An incomplete form will be returned to you, which will delay your financial aid.**
2. Send this completed form to the address or fax above.
3. We may need information on other verifiable items. Please check your 2023-2024 Financial Aid Document Status on the Portal and submit all other incomplete items.
