# **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

Unless otherwise instructed, in the event of an evacuation the designated assembly areas are the parking lots of unaffected buildings.

#### **EVACUATION PROCEDURES**

- → Walk, don't run, to the nearest exit.
- → Take personal belongings with you (keys, purse/wallet, etc.).
- → Quickly check in adjacent rooms and coordinate assistance if necessary.
- + Help individuals with disabilities exit the buildings.
- → Use posted evacuation routes to designated assembly areas.
- → Do NOT use elevators.
- Stay near the floor if air is toxic, be alert for hazards, move quickly and quietly.
- → Remain calm. Stay with your class or group pending further instructions.

#### VIOLENT INTRUDER/DISRUPTIVE PERSON(S)

For active shooter, see "Run, Hide, Fight" poster

- → PHYSICAL VIOLENCE:
  - Do not try to engage any violent person.
  - Isolate the area and call for Public Safety, ext. 5-1205 (802.635.1205).
  - Protect yourself and remain calm.
  - Observe reasonable requests but do not volunteer any information.

#### → DISAGREEMENTS:

- Do not do anything to escalate the argument.
- Use a modulated, controlled tone to request that the individual stop the disruptive behavior.
- If appropriate, ask the person(s) to leave.

## **MEDICAL EMERGENCY**

- → Identify the problem.
- → If a true medical emergency call 911 and Public Safety, ext. 5-1205 (802.635.1205).
- → Tell the 911 dispatcher:
  - Your location, including building and floor.
  - Name and condition of patient.
  - Information on medic alert bracelet, if present.
- If possible, arrange to have someone meet emergency personnel for direction to the exact location of the patient.
- → Secure the area.
- → Ensure the safety of the victim, but do not move him or her.
- → Stay with the victim.

#### FIRE OR EXPLOSION

- Activate the nearest fire alarm and call 911 and Public Safety, ext. 5-1205 (802.635.1205).
- Evacuate the building following the posted evacuation routes to designated assembly areas.
- ➔ Do NOT use elevators.
- → Close doors as you leave to prevent the spread of fire.
- → Do not open doors that feel hot to the touch.
- → Check stairwell for smoke and heat. If present, use an alternate stairwell.
- → Stay together with your class or group.
- → Do not reenter the building unless released to do so by emergency personnel.



#### SUSPICIOUS OBJECT

- → Do not touch or disturb object.
- → Notify your supervisor, RA or HA.
- Call Public Safety, ext. 5-1205, (802.635.1205) and 911 as needed.

# HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

*If unidentified substances or vapors are involved, assume they are toxic and hazardous until determined otherwise.* 

- Evacuate the affected area. Do not risk contact or further exposure to yourself.
- If an emergency or if anyone is in danger, call 911 or Public Safety, ext. 5-1250, (802.635.1205).



 Report the nature and location of the material and any medical emergencies or concerns.

## SHELTER IN PLACE

- → Move to the nearest classroom or secure space.
- Lock/barricade door with desks, chairs, furniture, etc.



- → Stay away from windows and doors.
- → Turn off lights, silence phones, pull shades.



- ✤ Do get to know the building evacuation procedures.
- → Do learn the location of fire alarms, extinguishers and AEDs in your building.
- → Do make sure you know the needs of anyone with disabilities in your area.
- → Do understand your roles and responsibilities during an emergency.
- → Do make sure your students/staff are aware of emergency procedures.
- → Do ensure that your emergency contact information is up to date.
- → Don't use elevators when evacuating a building.
- Don't re-enter a building after evacuating until told to do so by emergency personnel.
- Do not speak to the media. Direct all inquiries to the Director of Communications at 802.635.1664. If no answer, ask Public Safety to page the director.

#### **POWER OUTAGE**

- → Remain calm; provide assistance to others if necessary.
- If visibility is impaired by low light, wait for direction from staff. Emergency lights will come on automatically.
- → Report outage and any related hazards to Public Safety, ext. 5-1205 (802.635.1205).
- If necessary to evacuate the building, wait until it is safe to do so.
- If you become trapped in an elevator, use the emergency call button on the elevator panel to call Public Safety or call Public Safety directly at 802.635.1205.
