

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

Unless otherwise instructed, in the event of an evacuation the designated assembly areas are the parking lots of unaffected buildings.

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

- → Walk, don't run, to the nearest exit.
- → Take personal belongings with you (keys, purse/wallet, etc.).
- → Quickly check in adjacent rooms and coordinate assistance if necessary.
- → Assist individuals with disabilities in exiting the buildings.
- → Use posted evacuation routes to designated assembly areas.
- → Do NOT use elevators.
- → Stay near the floor if air is toxic, be alert for hazards, move quickly and quietly.
- → Remain calm. Stay with your class or group until further instructions are received.



VIOLENT INTRUDER/DISRUPTIVE PERSONS

(For active shooter, see "Run, Hide, Fight" poster)

- → Physical Violence:
 - Do not try to engage any violent person.
 - Isolate the area and call for Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452).
 - Protect yourself and remain calm.
 - Observe reasonable requests but do not volunteer any information.

→ Disagreements:

- Do not do anything to escalate the argument.
- Use a modulated, controlled tone to request that the individual stop the disruptive behavior.
- If appropriate, ask the person(s) to leave.



MEDICAL EMERGENCY

- → Identify the problem.
- → If a true medical emergency call 911 and Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452).
- → Tell the 911 dispatcher:
 - Your location, including building & floor.
 - Name and condition of patient.
 - Information on medic alert bracelet, if present.
- → If possible, arrange to have someone meet emergency personnel for direction to the exact location of the patient.
- → Secure the area.
- → Ensure the safety of the victim, but do not move him or her.
- → Stay with the victim.
- → All other medical issues call:

IMPORTANT DOS AND DON'TS

- → Do register foremergency notifications, NorthernVermont.edu/GetRave.
- → Do get to know the building evacuation procedures.
- → Do learn the location of fire alarms, fire extinguishers, and AED's in your building.
- → Do make sure you are aware of the needs of anyone with disabilities in your area.
- → Do understand your roles and responsibilities during an emergency.
- → Do make sure students/employees under your direction are aware of emergency procedures.
- → Do ensure that your emergency contact information is up-to-date.
- → Don't use elevators when evacuating a building.
- → Don't reenter a building after evacuating until released to do so by emergency personnel.
- → Don't speak to the media. All media inquiries should be directed to the Office of Communications, 802.626.6459.

FIRE OR EXPLOSION

- → Activate the nearest fire alarm and call 911 and Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452).
- → Evacuate the building following the posted evacuation routes to designated assembly areas.
- → Do NOT use elevators.
- → Close doors as you leave to prevent the spread of fire.
- → Do not open doors that feel hot to the touch.
- → Check stairwell for smoke and heat. If present, use an alternate stairwell.
- → Stay together with class or group.
- → Do not reenter the building unless released to do so by emergency personnel.



SUSPICIOUS OBJECT

- → Do not touch or disturb object.
- → Notify your supervisor, RA or RHD.
- → Call Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452) and 911 as needed.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Where unidentified substances or vapors are involved, assume they are toxic and hazardous until determined otherwise.

- → Evacuate the affected area. Do not risk contact or further exposure to yourself.
- → If an emergency or if anyone is in danger, call 911 or Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452).
- → Report to LSC staff the nature and location of the material and report any medical emergencies or concerns.



SHELTER IN PLACE

- → Move to the nearest classroom or secure space.
- → Lock/barricade door with desks, chairs, furniture, etc.
- → Stay away from windows and doors.
- → Turn off lights and pull shades on windows.



POWER OUTAGE

- → Remain calm; provide assistance to others if necessary.
- → If visibility is impaired by low light, wait for direction from staff. Emergency lights will come on automatically.
- → Report outage and any related hazards to Public Safety, ext. 6-6452 (cell phone 802.626.6452).
- → If necessary to evacuate the building, wait until it is safe to do so.
- → If you become trapped in an elevator, use the emergency call button located on the elevator panel to notify Public Safety, or call them at 802.626.6452.
