

Congratulations on your admittance to Vermont State University's Professional Pilot Technology program!

Please read the following important information regarding requirements for entry into the program:

- A clear, unrestricted, First or Second Class FAA Medical Certificate (First class highly recommended) issued by an FAA certified Aviation Medical Examiner (AME) is a requirement for admission into this degree program. Locating and scheduling an FAA Physical may be time consuming; applicants are encouraged to do this as soon as practical but must submit their medical prior to the first day of class.
- A background check and fingerprinting is required for students to receive their Security Identification Display Area badge (SIDA) for flying out of the Burlington International Airport. Vermont Flight Academy is responsible for assisting students with this. A checklist of required items will be sent to each accepted student after they complete their interview with the Director.
- Short interview to answer questions with Professional Pilot Technology program director Robin Guillian. Please email [Robin.Guillian@VermontState.edu](mailto:Robin.Guillian@VermontState.edu) to make arrangements. If students have prior flight time, this will also be discussed.
- All students must attend orientation to complete required paperwork.
- Review Flight Fees and pilot supply requirements on the web site at [VermontState.edu/Pilot-Fees](http://VermontState.edu/Pilot-Fees). These are not included with tuition and must be paid before the start of classes so flying is not delayed.
